

PLAN COMMISSION – JUNE 27, 2011

On Monday, June 27, 2011, the Town of Raymond, Planning Commission held their regular monthly meeting.

Commissioner Strohmeier called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Present were: Commissioners, Boldt; Strohmeier; Sinda; Strueder; Binhack; Cantwell and Brenton. Also present were Town Board members, James Phillips and Joe Pohlhammer. Ten residents were also present.

Appoint Commissioner Strohmeier as Chairman, made on a **BOLDT/BINHACK MOTION. MOTION CARRIED 7-0.**
